



Electricity Terms

Below is a summary of terms you may see on your monthly bill that may differ from other bills you may have seen, and what they mean.

Pass-Through Charges or Utility Charges

Sometimes called “TDU Delivery Charges”, these are costs to deliver you electricity through the grid that are passed through to you from the utility company (typically Oncor, Centerpoint, TNMP, or AEP). These charges enable the delivery of electricity to you via the grid.

Battery Adjustment or Battery Charging Credit

This cost is a credit to you for the energy used to charge and operate the battery on your home.

Your Consumption

This is the consumption as measured by the TDU’s meter (typically clear plastic, circular). This includes all energy delivered to the home, inclusive of that used to charge the battery.
