Battery Time of Use Supply Plan

Terms and Conditions of Service

We're glad you're on board with Base! We know you have options, and we're grateful for your trust. This document ("**Agreement**") outlines everything you need to know about our agreement to serve as the Alternative Retail Electric Supplier ("**ARES**") for your residence in ComEd territory ("**Property**"), including what you can expect from us, how to get in touch, and details about billing. We're committed to complete transparency, so please take a look and let us know if you have any questions. Thanks again for choosing Base Retail!

A. SUPPLY AGREEMENT DISCLOSURES

The following Terms and Conditions of Service apply to the provision of electric supply to the customer ("**you**") by Base Retail, LLC ("**Base Retail**"), an Illinois-licensed ARES. These Terms and Conditions, together with the Uniform Disclosure Statement ("**UDS**"), form the complete agreement between you and Base Retail.

ARES Legal Name. Base Retail, LLC

Business Address. 205 E Riverside Drive, Austin Texas 78704.

Product. The Battery Time of Use ("**TOU**") Supply Plan is designed for ComEd residential customers whose Property either (a) meets Base Retail's Peak Load Contribution ("**PLC**"), Network Service Peak Load Contribution ("**NSPLC**"), and energy usage requirements or (b) receives battery services from an energy storage device owned by Base Power Development, LLC ("**Battery System**") per a battery-services agreement that you enter into with Base Power Development, LLC ("**Battery Services Agreement**"). Base Power Development, LLC is an affiliate of Base Retail under common ownership.

Supply charges. The supply charge shall be a variable TOU rate, indexed to ComEd's Price to Compare ("**PTC**"), excluding the Purchased Electricity Adjustment ("**PEA**"). Base Retail expects the PTC to be available on the Illinois Commerce Commission's ("**ICC**")s pluginillinois.org website and derivable from ComEd's tariffs. In the event of an inconsistency between pluginillinois.org and ComEd's tariffs, ComEd's tariffs shall govern. Your supply charge will change depending on the time of day and day of week (i.e., "**on-peak**" or "**off-peak**"), and your on-peak and off-peak rates will change when ComEd's PTC changes.

On-Peak Supply Rate: 7AM–11PM, Monday through Friday: twenty five percent (25%) below ComEd's PTC.

Off-Peak Supply Rate: All other hours, all other days: twenty seven percent (27%) below ComEd's PTC.

Based on the current ComEd PTC of 10.399 ¢/kWh, your current rates are:

- On-Peak 7.799¢/kWh.
- Off-Peak 7.591¢/kWh.

Rate and discount guarantees. Base Retail guarantees that your on-peak supply rate will be no greater than 25% below ComEd's published PTC, and your off-peak supply rate will be no greater than 27% below ComEd's published PTC, each in effect at the time the supply rate applies.

Contract and renewal terms. The "**Initial Term**" of this Agreement begins on the date that Base Retail begins to serve as the retail electric supplier for the Property ("**Effective Date**") and ends twenty-four (24) months from the Effective Date, as defined in Section G of this Agreement. The Agreement will automatically renew at the end of the Initial Term according to terms outlined in the renewal offer. Base Retail will send a written renewal notice no later than 30 days and no earlier than 60 days before the end of the Initial Term, and each term thereafter. Base Retail will automatically renew this Agreement with a supply rate below the greater of (a) the average PTC plus PEA adjustment over the last 12 months and (b) PTC at the time of renewal, unless calculations for PTC have structurally changed during the then-current term of the Agreement.

Termination. You have a right to terminate this Agreement at any time with no early termination fees or



penalties. See Section J of this Agreement for important additional information regarding termination.

Deposit. Base Retail will not charge you a deposit for its retail electric services.

Rescission. You may rescind your enrollment with Base Retail within ten (10) calendar days of the date on ComEd's written notice to you confirming your switch to Base Retail. To rescind your enrollment, contact Base Retail at 1-866-479-POWR (7697) or support@basepowercompany.com, or contact ComEd at 1-800-334-7661.

Supplier disclosure. Base Retail is an independent electric supplier certified by the ICC (License No. 26-0121), and Base Retail is not representing, endorsed by, or acting on behalf of, a utility or utility program, a consumer group or consumer group program, or a governmental body or governmental program.

Utility responsibility. ComEd remains responsible for delivery services—the physical delivery of electric energy to your Property—and will continue to respond to any service calls and emergencies. When you enroll with Base Retail, you will receive written notification from ComEd confirming a switch of your electricity supplier.

Switching fees. There are no fees charged by Base Retail for switching your electric supplier to Base Retail.

Uniform Disclosure Statement. A summary document entitled The Uniform Disclosure Statement (“UDS”) is attached to this Agreement. The UDS contains important disclosures about your supply rate and your right to end this Agreement without termination fees or penalties under this Agreement. Please read both this Agreement and the UDS carefully. Note that if you have signed a Battery Services Agreement with Base Power Development, LLC, you may be subject to cancellation fees upon termination of this Agreement; please refer to the Battery Services Agreement for the terms of that agreement.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICE

You appoint Base Retail as the ARES for the Property served by ComEd. Base Retail agrees to sell, and you

agree to buy, all of your electric energy subject to the terms of this Agreement and in accordance with Base Retail's Illinois ARES license. You will be charged under this Agreement for all electric energy consumed by the Property. This Agreement governs only the supply of energy itself; ComEd remains responsible for the delivery of that energy to your Property.

C. CUSTOMER CONSENT AND INFORMATION RELEASE AUTHORIZATION

By entering into this Agreement, you authorize Base Retail to obtain information from ComEd that includes, but is not limited to, your billing history, payment history, historical and expected electricity usage, meter readings, characteristics of electricity service, address, telephone number, and electric utility account number(s). You authorize ComEd to release such information to Base Retail. Pursuant to a separate Letter of Agency, you authorize Base Retail to access your interval data usage. You represent that you are authorized to grant these consents with respect to all electric utility accounts subject to this Agreement.

D. VARIABLE TIME OF USE RATE AND PRICE

Base Retail will supply your electricity at a variable TOU rate indexed to the PTC. Your per-unit supply charge will differ based on the time of day and day of week as follows:

On-Peak Supply Rate: 7AM–11PM, Monday through Friday: twenty five percent (25%) below ComEd's PTC.

Off-Peak Supply Rate: All other hours, all other days: twenty seven percent (27%) below ComEd's PTC.

Your rate will change when the PTC changes. Your supply price does not include ComEd delivery charges, taxes, or other non-bypassable utility charges, which will continue to be billed by ComEd.

E. HOW YOUR CHARGES AND CREDITS WORK

Supply Charges. For each billing period, your supply charges are calculated by applying the applicable TOU rate to your Property's electricity consumption, which is defined as all consumption by the Property. Base Retail will calculate your electricity consumption using a



combination of your Advanced Meter Infrastructure (“**AMI**”) meter data and telemetry from the Battery System serving the Property, if one is installed.

Battery Credits, Charges, and Net Metering. See Net Metering Addendum.

Metering Information. Your utility operates the Property’s AMI meter; Base Retail is not responsible for any errors in metering by your utility. If you have signed a Battery Services Agreement and a Battery System is serving your Property, Base Power Development, LLC or one of its affiliates will operate the Battery System’s telemetry; Base Retail or its affiliate will take commercially reasonable steps to ensure the Battery System’s telemetry is within the accuracy tolerances established under 83 Ill. Admin. Code 410.150, which requires that meter registration be no less than 98% and no greater than 102% of actual consumption (“**Tolerance**”). In the event Base Retail has actual knowledge of a metering error by your utility that is not in your favor, Base Retail will take commercially reasonable steps to seek redress for you. In the event Base Retail has actual knowledge of a metering error in the Battery System’s telemetry, Base Retail will take commercially reasonable steps to repair the meter to bring it within Tolerance.

F. EQUIPMENT CHARGE DISCLOSURE

All charges associated with the Battery System provided by Base Retail affiliate Base Power Development, LLC—including the Installation Fee, any Cancellation Charges, and any other charges under the Battery Services Agreement—are charged by Base Power Development, LLC, and not by Base Retail. Such Battery System charges are separate from your electric supply charges under this Agreement.

G. TERM

This Agreement will become effective on the date that Base Retail begins to serve as the retail electric supplier for the Property (the “**Effective Date**”). If you have signed a Battery Services Agreement with Base Power Development, LLC, Base Retail will submit your enrollment request for electric services on the enrollment cycle that most closely aligns with your Battery System’s installation date—Base Retail will hold your enrollment information until that time. The initial term of this

Agreement is twenty-four (24) months from the Effective Date (“**Initial Term**”).

H. BILLING AND PAYMENT

Under ComEd’s Purchase of Receivables with Consolidated Billing (“**PORCB**”) program, you will continue to receive a single, consolidated monthly bill from your utility, ComEd. That utility bill will include both your utility’s delivery charges and other fees, along with Base Retail’s energy supply charges. Base Retail supply charges and credits will appear as a separate line item (or separate line items) on your utility bill. You agree to pay your utility bill in full by the due date. If you do not pay your bill by the due date, your utility may take action against you, including but not limited to imposing late fees in accordance with ComEd’s tariff, and your electric service may be disconnected. Failure to pay amounts owed to Base Retail may result in Base Retail terminating this Agreement. Despite such termination, you will remain liable for all charges for services rendered prior to the termination of this Agreement. If your electric service is disconnected, such disconnection will constitute a default under this Agreement, and Base Retail reserves the right to terminate this Agreement immediately. If the PORCB billing program is discontinued, you agree to pay Base Retail directly for any amounts invoiced, whether invoiced by Base Retail or by a third party on behalf of Base Retail.

Base Retail initially intends to bill you through ComEd’s PORCB program, as described above. Base Retail reserves the right to change its billing method to: (a) Dual Billing where Base Retail will issue you a separate bill for supply charges and credits, in which case those charges will no longer appear on your ComEd bill; or (b) Single Bill Option where Base Retail issues you a consolidated bill that includes both Base Retail’s supply charges and ComEd’s delivery charges. In either event, you will remain responsible for all charges owed to ComEd for delivery services.

If Base Retail elects to change its billing method, Base Retail will provide you with at least thirty (30) days’ written notice that includes the new billing and payment terms. During this notice period, you may terminate this Agreement without penalty by contacting Base Retail, and Base Retail will facilitate the reinstatement of your account to ComEd’s default electric service. A change in billing



method will not affect your supply rates under this Agreement.

I. RENEWAL

The Initial Term of this Agreement is twenty-four (24) months from the Effective Date. This Agreement will automatically renew for successive terms (“**Renewal Terms**”) as described below, unless you notify Base Retail of your intent not to renew prior to the deadline stated in the renewal notice.

Renewal Offer. No later than thirty (30) days and no earlier than sixty (60) days before the end of the Initial Term or any Renewal Term, Base Retail will provide you with a written renewal offer at the email address you provided to Base Retail. The renewal offer will include: (a) the proposed renewal term length; (b) the rates applicable to the Renewal Term; (c) methodologies by which charges and credits will be calculated and applied; and (d) instructions for how to accept or reject the renewal offer.

Automatic Renewal. At the end of the Initial Term or any Renewal Term, this Agreement will automatically renew for a new Renewal Term on the terms set forth in the applicable renewal notice. To prevent automatic renewal, you must notify Base Retail of your intent not to renew before the deadline stated in the applicable renewal notice, through one of the following methods: (i) completing the online opt-out process at basepowercompany.com/Illinois to opt out of the renewal; (ii) calling Base Retail at 1-866-479-POWR (7697); or (iii) following any other method Base Retail may designate in the renewal notice. A Renewal Term will begin on the next available meter read date following ComEd’s processing of the renewal enrollment.

Effect of Non-Renewal. If you decline to renew this Agreement, it will expire at the end of the then-current term, and you will automatically be enrolled in ComEd’s default electric service (under Residential Real Time Pricing (“**RRTP**”) or TOU supply pricing). Base Retail has no obligation to continue supplying electricity after the expiration of the then-current term. Return to ComEd default service may take one to two billing cycles.

Renewal Terms. The terms and conditions for each Renewal Term will be set forth in the applicable renewal offer. Rates applicable to any Renewal Term may differ from the Initial Term rates and will be disclosed in the renewal offer. Base Retail will automatically renew this

Agreement with a supply rate below the greater of (a) the average PTC plus PEA adjustment over the last 12 months and (b) PTC at the time of renewal, unless calculations for PTC have structurally changed during the then-current term of the Agreement. Your decision to renew is voluntary; you are not required to renew your Agreement with Base Retail.

J. CANCELLATION AND EARLY TERMINATION

You have the right to terminate this Agreement with Base Retail AT ANY TIME WITHOUT TERMINATION FEES OR PENALTIES. To terminate, contact Base Retail at 1-866-479-POWR

(7697), support@basepowercompany.com, or through your online account at basepowercompany.com/Illinois. This limitation on termination fees does not apply to charges imposed outside of this Agreement. If you have entered into a Battery Services Agreement with Base Power Development, LLC, cancellation fees may apply in the event that you terminate this Agreement. If you move from the Property, you may also terminate this Agreement without penalty by notifying Base Retail of your move-out date and providing satisfactory evidence of your relocation. Base Retail may terminate this Agreement on thirty (30) days’ notice if: (a) you move or cease to be a ComEd utility customer at the Property; (b) your account becomes ineligible for ComEd’s PORCB program; or (c) ComEd discontinues its PORCB program, and you fail to pay amounts due under this Agreement and do not cure such non-payment within fifteen (15) days of Base Retail giving you notice of such non-payment; or (d) the Property is no longer receiving battery services under Base Power Development, LLC’s Battery Services Agreement and the Property fails Base Retail’s usage, PLC and NSPLC criteria. Upon any termination of this Agreement, you will automatically be enrolled in ComEd’s default electricity service.

K. RESCISSION

You may rescind your enrollment with Base Retail within ten (10) calendar days after the date on ComEd’s (your utility’s) written notice to you confirming the switch to Base Retail’s electric services. To rescind, contact Base Retail



at 1-866-479-POWR (7697) or support@basepowercompany.com, or contact ComEd at 1-800-334-7661.

L. ADVERSE MATERIAL CHANGE

This Agreement may be revised by Base Retail upon the occurrence of an event beyond Base Retail's reasonable control that materially alters Base Retail's obligations under this Agreement, including a Change of Law. In such circumstances, Base Retail will notify you and offer revised terms. If you do not accept the revised terms in writing within thirty (30) days of that notice, Base Retail may terminate this Agreement. A **"Change of Law"** means any change in—or change in the applicability of—any law, rule, regulation, statute, order, directive, or regulatory action applicable to this Agreement, you, Base Retail, or Base Retail's ARES operations.

M. RATE AND DISCOUNT GUARANTEE

Base Retail guarantees that your on-peak and off-peak supply rates will remain at 25% and 28% below the ComEd PTC, respectively, as described in this Agreement for the initial term. However, Base Retail does not guarantee that your total electricity bill will be lower than it would be under ComEd's default service, as your actual bill will depend on your electricity usage, ComEd's delivery charges, applicable taxes, and other non-bypassable charges. Base Retail will renew this Agreement with a supply rate below the greater of (a) the average PTC plus PEA adjustment over the last 12 months and (b) PTC at the time of renewal, unless calculations for PTC have structurally changed during the then-current term of the Agreement.

N. INDEPENDENT SELLER DISCLOSURE

Base Retail, LLC is an independent retail electric supplier certified by the ICC (License No. 26-0121). Base Retail is not representing, endorsed by, or acting on behalf of, ComEd or any utility program, a consumer group or consumer group program, or a governmental body or governmental program. ComEd remains responsible for the delivery of electricity to the Property.

O. ELIGIBILITY

This Agreement is available to residential electric customers of ComEd at the Property identified at the time of enrollment. Base Retail reserves the right to verify your account eligibility and may decline enrollment if your payments are not up to date on your non-bypassable utility charges. Eligibility for this Battery TOU Supply Plan requires that you (a) meet Base Retail's PLC, NSPLC, and usage criteria or (b) maintain active battery services at the Property at all times during the Initial Term and any subsequent term of this Agreement under the Battery Services Agreement. If you do not have an AMI meter, you are not eligible for this plan and Base Retail reserves the right to terminate this Agreement.

P. PRIVACY AND DATA USE

Base Retail will use your account information and energy usage data to administer this Agreement and to manage your energy supply and billing. If you enter into a Battery Services Agreement with Base Power Development, LLC, Base Retail will also share such information with Base Power Development, LLC to operate the Battery System at the Property. Base Retail will not sell or disclose your personal information to unaffiliated third parties except as required to perform services under this Agreement or as required by law. For more information, see the Base Retail privacy policy at basepowercompany.com/privacy-policy.

Q. NOTICES

Except as otherwise set forth in this Agreement or required by applicable law, all notices to be provided under this Agreement shall be sent electronically to the email address you provide at enrollment. You may request paper copies, at no additional cost, at any time by contacting Base Retail. You agree to notify Base Retail promptly if your email address changes.

R. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

If you have a dispute with Base Retail, you agree to first attempt to resolve the matter informally by contacting Base Retail at 1-866-479-POWR (7697) or support@basepowercompany.com. If the dispute is not resolved informally, you may file a complaint with the ICC's Consumer Services Division at 1-800-524-0795 or at icc.illinois.gov as well as with the Illinois Attorney General - Public Inquiry Division at 1-800-386-5438 or



illinoisattorneygeneral.gov/File-A-Complaint/. Base Retail will cooperate fully with the Commission's complaint and dispute resolution process. Filing a complaint with the ICC does not limit your right to pursue other legal remedies available under Illinois law. You agree to raise any dispute that is within the jurisdiction of the ICC before the ICC.

S. DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATION

IF THIS AGREEMENT WAS ENTERED INTO AS A RESULT OF A SOLICITATION AT YOUR RESIDENCE, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THIS AGREEMENT WITHIN THREE (3) BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE DATE YOU ENTERED INTO THIS AGREEMENT, PURSUANT TO THE ILLINOIS HOME SOLICITATION SALES ACT (815 ILCS 505/2B). To exercise this right, you must notify Base Retail in writing within three (3) business days by calling 1-866-479-POWR (7697) or by emailing support@basepowercompany.com. This three (3) business day right is in addition to, and does not replace or limit, the ten (10) calendar day rescission right described in the Rescission section above.

T. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

LIABILITIES NOT EXCUSED BY REASON OF FORCE MAJEURE OR OTHERWISE SHALL BE LIMITED TO DIRECT AND ACTUAL DAMAGES AS THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY, AND ALL OTHER REMEDIES OR DAMAGES ARE EXPRESSLY WAIVED. NEITHER PARTY WILL BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, OR INDIRECT DAMAGES. BASE RETAIL'S LIMITATIONS APPLY WITHOUT REGARD TO THE CAUSE OF ANY LIABILITY OR DAMAGE. BASE RETAIL WARRANTS TITLE TO ALL ELECTRICITY SOLD HEREUNDER; BASE RETAIL EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, WHETHER STATUTORY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED.

U. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party will be liable to the other for any failure or delay in performance under this Agreement to the extent such failure or delay is caused by a **"Force Majeure"** event, meaning any event beyond the affected party's reasonable control that could not have been prevented through reasonable diligence, including without limitation

acts of God, severe weather, grid emergencies, acts of governmental authority, or ComEd system outages. The party claiming Force Majeure must notify the other as soon as practicable and must use reasonable efforts to resume performance.

V. ASSIGNMENT

You may not transfer or assign this Agreement without Base Retail's prior written consent. Base Retail may assign this Agreement to another ARES without your consent, provided that the assignee agrees to be bound by the terms of this Agreement and Base Retail provides you with written notice of the assignment. Any such assignment shall not constitute a material change to this Agreement.

W. CHOICE OF LAW AND VENUE

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, without regard to conflicts of law principles. Any legal action arising out of or related to this Agreement shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Cook County, Illinois. You and Base Retail consent and irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of such courts.

X. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; SEVERABILITY; WAIVER

This Agreement, together with the UDS, Automatic Contract Renewal Notice, Letters of Agency for Interval Data and Supplier Switch, and the Net Metering Addendum, constitute the entire agreement between you and Base Retail regarding the subject matter hereof and supersede all prior discussions, representations, and agreements. Your Battery Services Agreement with Base Power Development, LLC is a separate agreement and is not superseded by this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, such provision will be enforced to the maximum extent permissible and the remainder of this Agreement will remain in full force. Base Retail's failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

Z. DEFINITIONS

"**Alternative Retail Electric Supplier**" or "**ARES**" means an entity licensed by the ICC to sell electric energy to retail customers.

"**Battery Services Agreement**" means the separate agreement between you and Base Power Development, LLC governing the Battery System.

"**Battery System**" means the energy storage device(s) owned by Base Power Development, LLC that may be installed at your Property.

"**ComEd**" means your utility, Commonwealth Edison Company, the local electric distribution company.

"**ICC**" means the Illinois Commerce Commission.

"**PORCB**" means Purchase of Receivables with Consolidated Billing, a ComEd billing program under which ComEd includes Base Retail's supply charges on your utility bill. The program is authorized by Section 16-118(c) of the Public Utilities Act and implementing tariffs under which your utility will place Base Retail's charges on your periodic utility bill.

"**Price to Compare**" or "**PTC**" means the electric supply price to compare published by ComEd and available at PlugInIllinois.org.

"**TOU**" means Time-of-Use, a rate structure under which the per-unit charge for electricity differs based on the time of day and day of the week.

Contract Renewal:	This Agreement renews automatically.
